The **Clinical Child/Adolescent Psychology fellowship** offers advanced outpatient training including conceptualization in empirically supported interventions for youth ages 2-18 with a minor rotation in medical specialty outpatient clinics to allow for a well-rounded experience. The fellow will have opportunities to build their own outpatient caseload based on training needs and interests, will participate and lead therapy groups, and will complete approximately one assessment case a month, with dedicated time for scoring and report writing.
